**Earth Corporation to Serve as Bronze Sponsor of the “Sedona Forum – Tokyo”
Hosted by the McCain Institute and the International House of Japan
~Contributing to Global Infectious Disease Prevention Through
MA-T[®], as Part of Its U.S.–Japan Expansion Efforts~**

Tokyo, Japan —Earth Corporation (Headquarters: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President & Representative Director: Katsunori Kawabata; hereinafter “Earth Corporation”) announced that it has decided to serve as a Bronze Sponsor of Sedona Forum Tokyo, an international policy forum scheduled to be held on January 15, 2026, at the International House of Japan (I-House) in Roppongi, Tokyo, hosted by the McCain Institute and the I-House.

Sedona Forum Tokyo represents the first occasion on which the Sedona Forum—traditionally hosted by the McCain Institute annually in Sedona, Arizona—will be convened outside the United States. The Sedona Forum is an international policy dialogue convened each spring in Sedona, Arizona, by the McCain Institute^{*1} in the United States, a nonpartisan organization tank that carries forward the ideals of the late U.S. Senator John McCain. Jack McCain, CEO of McCain Advisory, is a board member of the Institute.

The Forum brings together leaders from the United States and around the world, providing a platform for candid discussions on a wide range of pressing global challenges.

Past Sedona Forum participants have included former U.S. President Joe Biden, former U.K. Prime Minister Tony Blair, and Dr. Denis Mukwege of the Democratic Republic of the Congo, among policymakers, thought leaders, and humanitarian leaders from various fields.

The Tokyo edition marks the first time the Sedona Forum will be held outside the United States. Approximately 100 participants from Japan, the United States, and countries across Asia are expected to attend, with the agenda focusing on the most critical global and regional security issues.

* 2 MA-T[®] (Matching Transformation System[®]) is Japan's first oxidation-control technology capable of stably generating amounts of aqueous radicals on demand. It combines high disinfection and deodorization performance with safety, and has already been widely implemented across a variety of sectors including healthcare, dentistry, elder care, food safety, hospitality, and aviation services.

To promote the real-world implementation of MA-T[®], the Japan MA-T Industrial Association (<https://matjapan.jp>) was established in November 2020 as an industry-academia-government consortium. The association oversees quality assurance and proper usage certification systems, conducts joint research and pilot studies with industry partners, and advances efforts toward the establishment of international standards.

Earth Corporation has already been recognized for its MA-T[®] initiatives, receiving the Prime Minister's Award at the 6th Cabinet Office Japan Open Innovation Prize and the Minister for National Resilience Award at the 11th Japan Resilience Awards, and continues to drive the real-world implementation of this technology.
